Dear Hill n Dale Member:

I am sorry for the length of this letter but there is a lot of important information to share with you. We have been in direct contact with the Medina County Health Department, as well as Montville Township, and I am happy to announce that the Club will **open to shooting on a limited reservation basis beginning Saturday, April 18<sup>th</sup>**. The Health Department has asked the club to follow some strict rules. Hill n Dale asks for your help in following these rules to keep the club safe for everyone.

### Shooting

**Shooting will be available on a reservation basis (1-hour staggered start times for sporting clays, 5 stand, & skeet/trap). Reservations can be made up to 1 day in advance. Please call the lodge 330-723-5105 to arrange for a preloaded target card, tokens, shells, etc. (Gun Rentals will not be available.)** The lodge will be staffed during shooting hours (Tuesday -Saturday 9am-5pm and Sunday 10am-5pm). Afterhours shooting will not be available right now.

Reservations will begin tomorrow, Friday, April 17, at 9:00am.

The club buildings including the lodge will be closed except for designated staff.

Group sizes **are limited to 4 people max** (including non-shooters).

Target cards for sporting clays will be preloaded with either 550, 1200, or 2000 targets (\$200/\$400/\$660). The card will have your name on it and can be reloaded at \$.36/target. These cards can be used only during regular shooting hours with a reservation. The use of these preloaded cards allows you to use it on multiple visits and decreases the handling of cards by staff and other members.

We encourage all groups to walk or use your personal cart. If a rental cart is needed due to health issues, please limit to 1 person per cart (2 people if from same household).

The lodge staff member will set up and clean target cards and other items and have them ready for you on the **pickup table** on the front porch of the Lodge. A Ziplock bag with paper towels and disinfectant will be provided to each group to clean (or eliminate contact with) controllers.

All groups are asked to start on Station #1 of their respective course and shoot only that course. Please keep at least 4 stations between other groups. This will help us clean stations with disinfectant between groups.

While shooting, please continue to keep 6 foot spacing between your squadmates. Target cards should be handled by only one person and please limit the handling of the controller to 1-2 people. The Ziplock bag with disinfectant can be used to cover the controller so there is no direct contact with the controller. It is recommended to leave the controller in its cradle if possible.

Please do not share guns, shells, or other equipment.

When you are done shooting, please place your return items (clipboard with member signature/payment sheet) on the **return table** on the porch of the lodge. There will be a designated return area for all carts so they can be washed before the next use.

All charges will be applied to your member account to eliminate handling of cash and/or physical credit cards (credit card info may be left on payment sheet if you wish). **Remember to take your target card home so you can use it on your next visit.**

The last winter league course (South Course) will remain available until April 30<sup>th</sup>. The summer league will be postponed and rescheduled TBD.

**Skeet/Trap** – If another group is shooting on the trap/skeet field, please wait in your vehicle until your turn. If you are shooting, please respect your reserved timeslot and allow waiting shooters to start shooting when your time is complete. The small cabin on the West Skeet field is closed.

### **Fishing**

The procedures for check -in / check -out at the front barn remain unchanged. Please wipe down any surfaces you touch at the check in counter and on any boats. Please exercise **catch and release on all ponds** and **do not use the fish cleaning room.**

### **Hiking**

The club offers many opportunities to hike, walk, run, and ride bikes. Please be respectful of others and stay out of any posted areas.

### **General Info**

Please continue to help make everyone safer by following these guidelines:

**If you are sick or have been near someone who is sick, PLEASE STAY HOME.**

**Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly.**

**Cover your mouth when you sneeze or cough.**

**Always maintain 6 foot or more spacing between each other**

We are frequently cleaning all high use surfaces (controllers, carts, target cards, boats, etc.). Please help us keep these areas clean. We will have cleaning materials available in appropriate spots.

We are limiting our staff accordingly for everyone's protection. All staff members check their temperature before and after work and are instructed to stay home if there is any indication of a fever.

Thank you for your help. We want to make the club as safe as possible for everyone. We will continue to evaluate our procedures and make changes as appropriate.
